January

The "29th Prix de Lausanne" (22 - 28 January 2001) was held in the Swiss City of Lausanne. The Pierino Ambrosoli Foundation once again supported this prestigious international dance competition this year with a financial grant for the dance performances in the final round.

February

The second Swiss auditions for the Dutch "Rotterdamse Dansacademie", organized by the Pierino Ambrosoli Foundation, were successfully held in Berne on 3 and 4 February 2001 in cooperation with the Berne Municipal Theatre. 11 from 22 participants between 14 and 25 years old were selected to enter the final round and six participants were accepted as students of the school year 2001-2002. March

On 11 March, **Mattia Zappa** (cello), a former Pierino Ambrosoli Foundation scholarship holder, with his partner **Massimo Mainolfi** (piano), made their US debut in the **Weill Recital Hall** of the **Carnegie Hall**, New York, and received excellent critical acclaim. The Pierino Ambrosoli Foundation made this concert possible.

April

At the International Choreography Competition in Gland (CH), **Jasmine Morand** presented her first choreography "Cola on the side" with student colleagues from the "Rotterdamsen Dansacademie" and received excellent reports from the critics.

May

With Daniela Marcacci Ambrosoli, the Italian ballerina **Alessandra Ferri**, the photographer Fabrizio Ferri and the journalist Elisa Vaccarino further plans were made for a "Nijinsky" project in the "Industria" premises in Milan.

At the invitation of the Interlaken **Soroptimist Club**, Daniela Marcacci Ambrosoli gave a lecture on the work of the Pierino Ambrosoli Foundation and ballet instruction. This event attracted keen interest from all the participants.

The Pierino Ambrosoli Foundation made a grant towards the production of a CD by the Ticino rock group "Naïve" in recognition of the long activity and popularity of these talented young musicians.

June

In October 2000, Mrs Daniela Marcacci Ambrosoli was elected coordinator for education and culture of the **Soroptimist Union Switzerland**. In cooperation with the Soroptimist Union Switzerland, the Pierino Ambrosoli Foundation organized a benefit gala for the "Comité International pour la Dignité de L'Enfant, C.I.D.E." (International Committee for the Dignity of Children). More than 100 Soroptimists and visitors attended from all over Switzerland and enjoyed an exceptional evening. A substantial contribution was made to the C.I.D.E.

Lisa Öberg passed the final examination of the "Yehudi Menuhin School" in London with flying colours and can now look forward to an international career.

July

The **54th Locarno International Film Festival** was held from 2 to 12 August 2001: Daniela Marcacci Ambrosoli is a member of the Foundation Council of the **"Fondazione Montecinemaverità."**

The **Kinder- und Jugendtheater Mezenthin** of Zürich celebrated its 50th anniversary. On the same occasion, the school's founder, Mrs **Rosmarie Metzenthin**, feted her 75th birthday. The Pierino Ambrosoli Foundation made a grant in support of the school.

November

Daniela Marcacci Ambrosoli and Michael Jürgens were invited to the "Holland Dance Festival" in The Hague. They also paid a visit to the "Rotterdamse Dansacademie" to meet Pierino Ambrosoli Foundation four scholarship holders locally.

This was followed by a visit to the head of the "International Lassaâd Theatre School", Mr Lassaâd Saïdi, in Brussels, with whom personal contact was made for the first time. A performance "My movements are like street dogs" by Jan Fabre was also attended.

December

On 8 December, Daniela Marcacci Ambrosoli attended the "Hommage à Rosella Hightower-carte blanche à Monique Loudières" gala performance of the "Ecole Supérieure de Danse International Rosella Hightower" in Cannes and watched an enchanting performance.
